4. WPCF Capital Infrastructure Projects: Stillwater Interceptor & Charles Street Rehabilitation

Staff has identified a section approximately 600 ft. long of the Stillwater Interceptor between Noyes Drive and Main Street as well as the main on Charles Street that need to be rehabilitated (relined). Working with Olver Associates, staff has developed design, contract administration, and inspection budgets and agreements for both the projects. Staff brings this item forward for the Committee's consideration of funding design and contract development (bidding and bid award) in FY16 for FY17 construction.

5. Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Master Plan Implementation Proposal

Staff will review the Town's CSO Master Plan and permitting process as well as to determine the Committee's support in developing an implementation plan for further reducing infiltration from non-Town owned sources.
