The Town has embarked on a process to learn more about the community's vision for indoor community space and if/how the Town's current inventory of buildings used for community purposes and/or vacant may meet that vision. Buildings under discussion are:

- Keith Anderson Community House (Bennoch Rd);
- Birch Street School/Parker Dining Room (Pine St);
- The Old Fire Station (aka Boy Scout Building on North Main Ave); and
- The Former Public Works Garage (Penobscot St).

The outcome of this process will be a plan, developed with the Town Council, to articulate goals, prioritize future capital investments, and identify potential collaborative relationships aimed at meeting longer-term community needs.

While the project team will be engaging current tenants and identified stakeholders, the Town wants to better understand the community's needs, current and future, for indoor community space. Earlier this summer, the Town hosted an in-person meeting to listen to community member feedback. This virtual meeting will provide another opportunity for community members to share their thoughts about current and future community space needs.
